If the vessel ceases to be a New Zealand flagged vessel the master, operator or owner must immediately notify the Chief Executive of the Ministry of Fisheries in writing and the registration of the vessel on the New Zealand Western Central Pacific Fisheries Convention Vessel Register will be cancelled immediately.

If any of the details relating to the registration of this vessel change, the master or operator must immediately notify the Chief Executive of the Ministry of Fisheries in writing.
